Job Purpose: The Warehouse Distribution Specialist is a full-time position of eight hours daily. The right person for this job will assist in all areas of the warehouse and enjoy working alongside a team by performing various distribution duties, including operating electric pallet jacks and hand trucks.

Duties and Responsibilities

At Distributions

- Assist at various food distributions around the county, including availability early morning
- Assist scanning client cards for proper identification and access to food
- Help direct volunteers
- Able to lift a minimum of 30 pounds repeatedly
- Assist in cleanup of site following the close of each distribution and return to the Food Bank

At Warehouse/IVFB - Aten Road Facility

- Provide excellent customer service on dock when pulling and verifying agency orders
- Follow procedures pertaining to proper handling of receipts, agency orders and inventory documentation
- Assist in preparing orders for the next day's distribution
- Assist local agency representatives in picking up orders; may include writing and signing invoices
- Operate warehouse equipment in a safe manner
- Assist in conducting inventory
- Other duties as assigned
